The construction of Ndwedwe water and sewer reticulation

iLembe District Municipality invites Established Contractors to bid for the construction of Ndwedwe water and sewer reticulation

Only bidders who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being registered prior to the closing date of the bid, in a contractor grading equal to or higher than 7CE and potential emerging bidders with a classification of 6CE PE will be eligible to bid.

Bid Specification Documents together with the bid drawings will be available from Tuesday, 24 January 2012 until the close of business on Monday 30 January 2012 from the offices of the cashier at iLembe District Municipality, iLembe House, 59/61 Mahatma Gandhi Street, KwaDukuza, upon payment of a non-refundable cash deposit of R500.00. Bid documents will not be available at the site inspection meeting.

A compulsory site inspection will be held on Tuesday 31 January 2012 Prospective bidders shall meet at the Municipal Offices then proceed to the site briefing meeting. The Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion. Prospective contractors are required to bring their copies of the bid specification documents to the site inspection for signing by the Engineer.

Failure to obtain a bid specification document or non-attendance of the site inspection will result in the immediate disqualification of your bid. Bids may only be submitted on the bid specification documentation provided by the Municipality.

Sealed bids, endorsed "Invitation to Bid No. TS/57/2011: The construction of Ndwedwe water and sewer reticulation must be submitted into the bid box situated at the Ground Floor of iLembe Technical Services, 12 Haysom Road, KwaDukuza by no later than Friday 02 March 2012 at 12h00 where they will be opened in public. The address of the bidder must be clearly written on the envelope containing the bid. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the iLembe District Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy and the 90/10 preference point scoring system. iLembe District Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

iLembe District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any of the bids and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
