A **COMPULSORY BRIEFING SESSION** will be held at **11h00 on Wednesday 09 February 2011** at iLembe Enterprise Offices, 16 Old Main Road, uMhlali.

Failure to obtain a Bid Specification Document or non-attendance of the briefing session will result in the immediate disqualification of your bid. Bids may only be submitted on the bid specification documentation provided by the Municipality.

Proposals including associated costs must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly endorsed "**PD/02/2011: Preparation of the Regional Spatial Development Plan**", and deposited into the Bid Box situated at the Reception Area, **Ground Floor of Technical Services Building, No. 12 Haysom Road, KWA DUKUZA** by no later than **12 NOON on Wednesday, 16 February 2011** where they will be opened in public. The name and address of the bidder must be clearly written on the envelope. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days.

All Bidders must supply a Tax Clearance Certificate from SARS confirming that the Bidders Tax matters are in order or they must give authority to Ilembe District Municipality to obtain information from SARS regarding their Tax matters. Any bid that does not comply with the advert will be rejected and will not be considered.
