**Ndwedwe South System Refurbishment (Water Scheme)
Nkwambase and Sonkombo**

Ilembe District Municipality invites Established Contractors to tender for Ndwedwe South System Refurbishment (Water Scheme).

Only bidders / who are registered with the CIDB in a contractor registration equal to or higher than **7CE**.

The scope of works includes replacement and upgrading of existing bulk pipelines consisting of construction of 5.25km of ND150mm steel rising mains and 4.78km of ND160 PVC rising mains, repairs to existing reticulation pipelines and metered yard connections.

Bidders who fail to provide the relevant CIDB information called for in the paragraph above prior to the closing date of the bid shall be disqualified for further consideration.

Bid Specification Documents together with the bid drawings will be available from **Thursday, 31 January 2019** until the close of business on **Friday, 8 February 2019 at 15:00** from the offices of the Cashier at iLembe District Municipality, iLembe House, 59/61 Mahatma Gandhi Street, KwaDukuza, upon payment of a **non-refundable cash** deposit of R 500.00. Bid documents will **NOT** be available at the site inspection meeting.

A **COMPULSORY SITE INSPECTION** will be held at **10H00 on Monday, 11 February 2019**. Prospective Bidders shall meet the Engineer at **iLembe Water Service Office in Ndwedwe on Road P100 and/or opposite Nombika High School** and then proceed to site for a site briefing. The Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion. Prospective bidders are required to bring their copies of the bid specification documents to the site inspection for signing by the Engineer and Municipal officials. All bids will be signed on site.

Failure to obtain a Bid Specification Document and non-attendance of the site inspection will result in the immediate disqualification of your bid. Bids may only be submitted on the bid specification documentation provided by the Municipality.

All bidders must submit a Tax Clearance Certificate, or South African Revenue Services (SARS) UNIQUE PIN to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status online via E-filing. Any bid that does not comply with the advert will be immediately disqualified and will not be considered. Ilembe District Municipality Reserves its Right to Verify the Validity of the submitted Tax Clearance Certificates in terms of Section 256 (5) of the Tax Administration Act no.28 of 2011 and will apply MFMA circular 43 and Section 38 of the iLembe District Municipality's SCM Policy where necessary. All bidders must provide audited financial statements (AFS) for companies required by law to be audited. All bidders must be registered on the National Treasury Central Suppliers Database (CSD) and must submit proof of registration.

Sealed bid endorsed "**Invitation to Bid No. TS/197/2019, Ndwedwe South System Refurbishment (Water Scheme) Nkwambase and Sonkombo**" must be submitted into the Bid Box situated at the **Ground Floor of ILEMBE TECHNICAL SERVICES BUILDING, 12 Haysom Road, KWA DUKUZA** by no later than **12 Mid-Day on Monday, 4 March 2019** where they will be opened in public. The name and address of the bidder must be clearly written on the envelope containing the bid. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of iLembe District Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy in two stages. First stage of evaluation is functionality and the second stage being the 80/20 preference point scoring system. Only bidders who score the required minimum threshold on functionality criteria will qualify for the second stage of evaluation. This bid will be evaluated in terms of the 2017 Preferential Procurement Regulations pertaining to the PPPFA (No. 5 of 2000), the municipal reserves the right to enforce measures aimed at achieving radical socio-economic transformation objectives, including directing bidders to subcontract or partner with

local entities at least 51% owned by black people as stated on predetermined list in terms of Regulation 9 of the PPPFA Regulations, 2017.

The awarding of this bid is subject to the recommended bidders subcontracting a portion of the work to a local emerging entity at least 51% owned by black people. The selection of the entity to be sub-contracted will be informed by the Municipality's Radical Socio-Economic targets in terms of the set asides.

iLembe District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any of the bids and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
